



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given to all residents and property owners of the City of Delavan, Illinois, and all users of the Water Treatment and Distribution System that the City plans to replace water meters, to replace approximately 50 lead service lines, and to replace Well #2. This Notice is to provide an opportunity for the public to provide comments on the City's proposed construction project. A copy of the Water System Improvements Planning Study and a copy of the Preliminary Environmental Impacts Determination (PEID) document provided by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) are available for review at City Hall, 219 Locust St., Delavan, IL 61734. These documents contain information including the project costs, location, user rate impacts, and potential environmental impacts. The City intends to fund the project through the IEPA Public Water Supply Loan Program (PWSLP).

The public hearing is scheduled at 6:30 p.m. on January 2nd, 2024 at City Hall (219 Locust St., Delavan, IL 61734).

Public comments will be received for up to 10 days following the public hearing.
